
TO TAKE RT-PCR COVID-19 DETECTION TEST THREE (3) DAYS BEFORE LEAVING FOR MALAYSIA

ALL NON-MALAYSIAN CITIZENS (BWN) ARRIVING IN MALAYSIA WILL BE CHARGED WITH THE FULL NON-SUBSIDIZED FEES

FULL PAYMENT FOR THE QUARANTINE AND COVID-19 DETECTION TEST CAN BE DONE ONLINE VIA MySafeTravel / MyQr Application by MyEG

## **TEMPORARY ENTRY BAN TO MALAYSIA FOR 6 COUNTRIES**







Malaysia Government has imposed a temporary entry ban on citizens of SIX (6) countries to curb the further spread of the COVID-19 pandemic.

In this regard, students from UNITED KINGDOM, INDIA, BANGLADESH, PAKISTAN, NEPAL, and SRI LANKA will NO LONGER BE ALLOWED entry into Malaysia until further notice.

#### STUDENTS ENTERING MALAYSIA WITH THE RT-PCR REPORT





International students with <u>complete COVID-19</u> <u>vaccination</u> or <u>with COVID-19 infection history</u> can apply for quarantine exemption at the quarantine station and opt to home quarantine by submitting the application to <u>hso@moh.gov.my</u>.

However, this quarantine exemption at the quarantine station is NOT ELIGIBLE for students from the countries with reported community transmission of a Variant Of Concern (VOC) SARS-CoV-2

### **INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS WITH INFECTED COVID-19 HISTORY**



Students WITH INFECTED COVID-19 HISTORY can undergo quarantine at home for 10 days without having to undergo a SAR-CoV-2 detection test and monitor their own health status using MySejahtera application for at least 14 days in compliance with these <u>THREE (3)</u> following criteria:

### **DI** DISCHARGE NOTE OR REPORT

Discharge note or report by medical practitioner proving the case has undergone isolation or treatment for at least <u>TEN (10) days</u> from the date of a positive COVID-19 laboratory test



Verify student's information before EMGS forwards the application to IMI for approval



Inform student of the latest backto-campus SOP in accordance to the orders, rules and guidelines set and updated by the Government from time to time and ensure student's adherence to the SOP

#### WHAT IS THE STUDENT'S RESPONSIBILITY



#### Pre Arrival

Obtain a Travel Notice from an accredited Malaysian Mission and an Entry Approval letter from the Director-General of Immigration (DGI)

Present the Travel Notice to airline companies, public transportations companies and the Immigration Department Malaysia (IMI)



Download, activate and register personal details on the MySejahtera application.

Pay full charge for the quarantine and the COVID-19 screening test via online system which is the MYSAFETRAVEL/ application MYQR by MYEG



Take a RT-PCR COVID-19 screening test THREE (3) days before arriving to Malaysia.



#### Upon Arrival



Present the Travel Notice to officers on-duty



Do health screening and take a COVID-19 detection test

#### Post Arrival



Register at the Quarantine Station

Do own health assessment daily during quarantine period

IN REFERENCE TO THE LATEST INSTRUCTIONS OF THE MALAYSIAN IMMIGRATION DEPARTMENT, INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS WITH VALID STUDENT PASS ARE PERMITTED TO EXIT THE COUNTRY UNCONDITIONALLY.




